THE ADVENTURER LEADERSHIP AWARD (ALA)

The ALA is recognised throughout the South Pacific Division as the introductory training package for you as a Adventurer leader or staff member.

The ALA will enable you to develop your leadership skills as you acquire a thorough understanding of the philosophy and practice of Adventuring. The ALA provides quality training in various aspects of club organisation, spiritual formation and outdoor skills.

Our desire is that the ALA will enable you to be more effective in your ministry, as you grow in knowledge and maturity as a leader of the Adventurers under your care. Your ability to work with and lead other young people into a committed relationship with Jesus Christ is of paramount importance.

PRE-REQUISITES

All course participants are required to:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Be a baptised member of the Seventh–day Adventist Church or be in preparation for baptism.
- Have current government or state required Working with Children certification or equivalent (where applicable).
- Have completed AdSafe training.
- Have annual AdSafe Code of Conduct.

COURSE REQUIRMENTS

Successful completion of the ALA requires you to attend and participate in two Conference-run training weekends - Part One & Part Two - as well as attain in-service training and personal and spiritual growth requirements.



PART ONE

Part one of the Conference training is taught across two days - Saturday and Sunday. You will need to arrange your own travel and accomodation to and from the venue each day. The units that will be covered include:

PART TWO
