2. Say three things that you learned about insects.

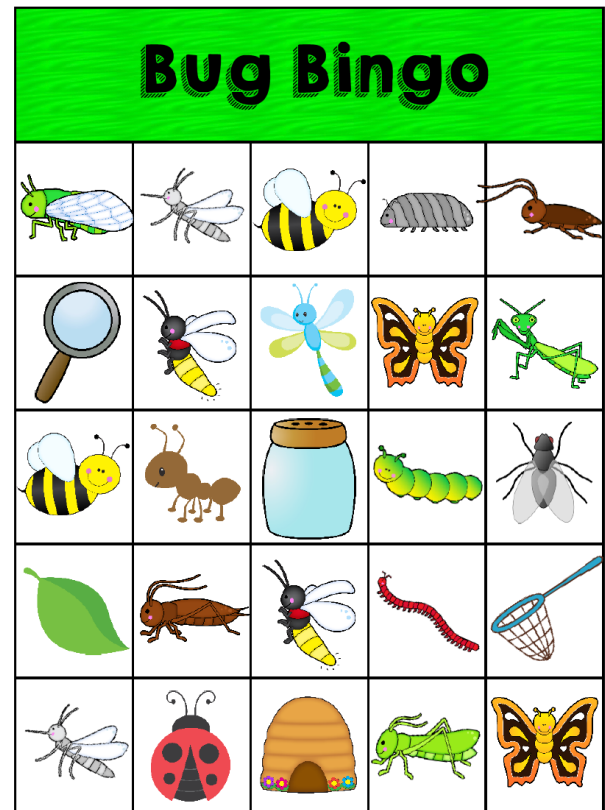
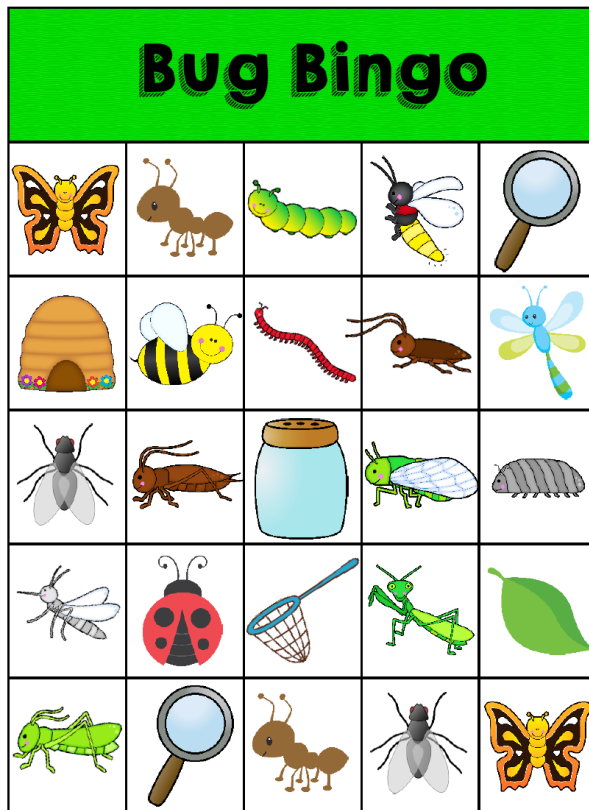
1. There are many different types of insects. In fact, there are more species of insects than any other type of animal.
