1. Know some of the basic parts of a camera.

Lens – The camera lens is used to focus and direct incoming light. It is made up of curved glass.

Shutter – The shutter opens and closes to allow the incoming light to reach the image sensor - this is where the image is recorded.

Zoom – is a function of the camera lens that allows you to see an image closer or farther away.

Screen/Viewfinder – the screen or eyepiece on a camera that you look through, to allow you to see what is being photographed.

Battery – a rechargeable device that is the power source of the camera.

Power Button - The button you press to turn the camera on and off.
