The Urban Expedition is unique in that it can be undertaken in your local area. The hiking component of the Expedition can be completed in your neighbourhood or local park and/or nature reserve.

Our spiritual focus for Expedition will be an exploration of the missionary journeys of Apostle Paul. As we go on our own journey over the weekend, we will reflect on the challenges and sucesses that Paul faced on his.

- 1. Complete a 10km walk.
- 2. Identify your chosen route on a map.
- 3. Take a bearing with a compass.
- 4. Take photographs of 5 plants and 5 animals on your walk and identify them.
- 5. Set up a tent or make-shift shelter and spend at least one night sleeping in it.
- 6. Outline your weekend camp menu.
- 7. Participate in an online or in-person club worship.
- 8. Write up daily journal entries of your experience over the weekend.



We know that Pathfinders love a bit of healthy competition. So, to make the Urban Expedition a bit more interesting, there will be a prize for the club that clocks up the most amount of steps over the month of November. To make sure every club has a fair chance to win, we will be dividing the score with the number of Pathfinders in the club to get the average.
